PILATUS recommends Operators of aircraft with affected Garmin equipment to comply fully with Service Alert 050721-00 which calls for immediate action as follows:

- The 'Direct-to' waypoint must be selected only by highlighting that waypoint in the flight plan and pressing the 'Direct-to' key
- **Do not** use any other method of entering the 'Direct-to' waypoint.

The problem will be corrected with the next issue of each software update.

- GNS 430/420/400 Main S/W versions 2.08 through 5.00
- All GNS 530/500 Main S/W versions through 6.00
- All G1000 GDU S/W versions through 5.00

<u>ISSUE</u>

In certain limited circumstances, conflicting navigation information can be provided when a selected 'Direct-to' waypoint is also a waypoint in a loaded terminal/approach procedure.

IMMEDIATE ACTION REQUIRED

This issue concerns only 'Direct-to' navigation to a waypoint that is already part of the loaded or active terminal/approach procedure. In this specific situation, the following applies:

 The 'Direct-to' waypoint must be selected only by highlighting that waypoint in the flight plan and pressing the 'Direct-to' key. Do not use any other method of entering the 'Direct-to' waypoint.
